



5. Remove the pillar seat belts, using plastic trim tool and ratchet wrench, as shown in fig.9 and fig.10.

6. Pull down the rubber seal on all doors, as shown in fig.11 and fig.12.

7. Remove rear the seat belt caps, using plastic trim tool and ratchet wrench, as shown in fig.13 and fig.14.



8. Remove the middle seat belt pillar (fig.15).

9. Remove the bolts and rubber stoppers from the rear panel (fig.16).



10. Remove the rear panel (fig.17).

16. Open the sunglesses compartment and pry the cosole downward (fig.23).

19. Lower the roof lining by detaching the magnetic connection point in the middle of the roof, as far as the wiring allows (fig.26)

20. Unscrew all 4 connection points, as shown in fig.27 and fig.28.

21. Peel the ditch rubbers upwards starting from the rear and making your way to the front on both sides of the vehicle. (fig.29).



22. Apply sealant to the spacers (item E) and the threads of the M8x16 bolts (item C) and fix the spacers to the center holes using bolts M8x16 (item C), spring washers 8 (item H) and reinforced flat washers (item M) (fig.30).

*Do not tighten yet.

23. Assemble the roof rack platform following the instructions 2M.0001.4 (fig.31).





24. Insert 4 bolts M8x20 (item B) into T-slots on both sides as shown in fig.32 and fig.33.



25. Install the right and the left brackets (item 1,2) on both sides of roof rack platform and fix using washers 8 (item I) and nuts M8 (item K) (fig.34).

*Tighten hardware after that.

26. Insert 4 bolts M8x20 (item B) into T-slot in the front of roof rack as shown in fig.35.




27. Install and fix the wind deflector bracket (item 4) on the roof rack platform using washers 8 (item I), nuts M8 (item K) (fig.36). *Tighten hardware after that.



28. Tape the guard film (item A) at a distance of 0.4 inch (10 mm) from the windscreen of the vehicle as shown in fig.37.



29. Cut ditch molding using dimensions: 1.6 inch (40mm), 45.3 inch (1150mm), 5.3 inch (135mm). Install cut parts as shown in fig.38.



30. Install the roof rack on the vehicle by placing it on spacers (item E) and fix using bolts M8x16 (item C), spring washers 8 (item H) and washers 8 (item L) (fig.39).



31. Install the wind deflector (item 3) and fix using screws M6x20 (item D) washers 6 (item G) and washers spring 6 (item F) (fig.40).
